SPECIAL CONGREGATIONAL MEETING JULY 27TH immediately following the worship service. The purpose of the meeting is to consider Conewago Township's offer to compensate Quickel Lutheran Church for the right-of-way required for transportation improvements along Canal Road. The areas required are a permanent Right-of-Way of 1,660 Square Feet, and a Temporary Construction Easement of 4,446 Square Feet. A letter from council president Jeff Shoener was distributed on July 10th via email and first class mail for those who do not have email access.
