NOTES FROM JUNE 9TH COUNCIL MEETING

- VBS donation to date is \$1,690
- Pavillion donation to date is \$4,435
- Council gave approval for Denise Nestlebush to look into getting a new computer and Windows program for the Secretary's office. There are still problems going on with the computer.
- Dave Miller has submitted an appeal for the Quickel's Property Assessment that was received for parcels, Parish House (church) and farmland (cemetery). The hearing is in August.
- Bazaar is being held on July 11, 2026, from 8am – 2pm at Quickel's church. Item drop off is July 7 and July 8 from 4 – 6pm .Set up is July 10 at 9am. Tear down is after church on July 12. Baked item donations are needed.
- Council approved two items from the Worship and Music Committee:
- The purchase of an omnidirectional microphone and removal of the sign holder across the street.
- Council approved an outside electric receptacle estimate for the new pavilion.
- Council approved an estimate for the new Nativity. Sandy Hawk will present information to the congregation in July.
- Council approved \$300 Mission Support to be given to United Lutheran Seminary in honor of Chris Frigm and Jim Goodyear, Jr.
